

# Southern Harvest 47G4

## Product Profile



This hybrid has very early maturity and has high grain yield potential for its earliness. Some of its major advantages are:

- Early maturity
- No tannin
- Very good standability
- Ease of harvest
- Short height

This hybrid has red seed color, large round grain, and high-test weight. The panicle is slightly open; glumes are awnless and cover less than one-third of the grain. Plant necrotic is purple, plant tissue is juicy, tillering capacity is good which allows the plant to compensate for environmental conditions. Tillers are approximately the same height of the main panicle. The hybrid appears very uniform in the field. Because the hybrid is so early it can be grown in short-season conditions and also in situations to escape drought in longer season conditions.
