

Southern Honey



- Brown Midrib Sorghum-Sudangrass
- High grain without tannin **qualifies it for 80% LDP**
- Extraordinary palatability for grazing or hay
- Good regrowth and recovery
- Slightly broader leaves and larger stems than conventional sorghum/sudangrass hybrids
- High daily weight gains from direct pasture
- High quality direct pasture and hay hybrid

This hybrid is a modified sorghum-sudangrass, which offers flexibility to producers for direct pasture or hay production. Performance in fields has shown from 75 to 100% greater daily weight gains over conventional sorghum-sudangrass hybrids. Its high level of palatability allows the hybrid to fit well into cell-grazing systems. This hybrid has a demonstrated ability to increase both meat and milk production dramatically, therefore producing greater profits per acre of pasture.
